The Security Officer main roles are maintaining a safe, and secure environment for employees, visitors, and guests while upholding the highest standards of customer service at The Forks, a historically significant gathering place in Winnipeg, Canada. Reporting directly to the security supervisors, security officers will foster empathetic and connection-based relationships within the diverse community of our site, creating a community safety culture that is inclusive, and fostering of a safe space.

Working Relationships:

- Build trust and rapport with visitors, guests, and employees, promoting a safe and welcoming atmosphere.
- Work as part of a cohesive team dedicated to ensuring the security and well-being of all.
- Communicate safety concerns, offer insights for improvements, and participate in creating a secure environment with leadership.
- Builds and maintains positive relationships with external contacts, including community outreach agencies and adjacent stakeholder organizations, for effective collaboration during incidents.

Skills Required:

- Required to maintain valid MB Security Guard Licence, MB OHS accredited First aid (intermediate), and smart choices certification.
- Capacity to walk, kneel, stand, travel stairs, and ride a bike, for up to, but not limited to 8+ hours, to maintain a safety and security presence on a site that spans approximately 52 acres.
- Capable of lifting + push/pull up to 50lbs.
- Exceptional interpersonal skills to connect with community members, address concerns, and provide assistance while demonstrating empathy and understanding.
- Proficiency in resolving conflicts peacefully, de-escalating situations, and maintaining a calm demeanor under pressure.
- The ability to attentively listen to community members' needs, concerns, and feedback, providing appropriate responses and support.
- Skillful response to emergencies, following established procedures while prioritizing safety and community well-being.
- Awareness and respect for diverse cultures, languages, and backgrounds, ensuring an inclusive and welcoming environment for all.
- Effective collaboration with colleagues and other departments to achieve shared goals of community safety and security.
- Keen attention to detail and situational awareness to identify potential risks or safety hazards.
- A dedication to providing a high level of customer service by assisting visitors, answering questions, and offering guidance.



Responsibilities:

- Establish trust and connections with community members by being approachable, responsive, and attentive to their needs and concerns.
- Maintain the integrity and security of the Market, and The Forks North Portage property, completing required daily duties, locks ups, and patrolling presence throughout the site.
- Address conflicts or disturbances with empathy, aiming for peaceful resolutions, and involving law enforcement only when necessary.
- Provide assistance, information, and guidance to community members, ensuring their comfort and safety.
- Respond promptly and compassionately to incidents and emergencies, following established safety protocols and communicating effectively with local authorities and management.
- Conduct regular safety inspections with a focus on maintaining a safe and inclusive environment for all community members. Report issues to appropriate parties in order to mitigate or remediate concerns of graffiti, spills, and overall site cleanliness and appearance.
- Maintain accurate records and incident reports, documenting interactions and security-related activities.
- Promote an environment of cultural sensitivity and inclusivity, respecting the diverse backgrounds and languages of community members.
- Continuously improve skills and knowledge through training, with a focus on communitycentered safety practices.
