- Offering a warm and friendly greeting to visitors, providing assistance as needed.
- Clearing used dishes, glassware, and waste from tables and public spaces, both from inside The Forks Market and The Forks Market patio.
- Sorting compostables, recyclables, and waste at the sort stations.
- Washing and delivering clean dishware, glassware, and cutlery to tenants of The Forks Market.
- Performing general cleaning duties, ensuring consistent and overall cleanliness of The Forks Market and The Forks Market patio. This could include sweeping and mopping floors, emptying garbage receptacles, and other general cleaning duties as assigned.
- Supporting with larger routine cleaning tasks in The Forks Market and The Forks Market patio.

- Has a friendly and positive demeanour.
- Is able to work independently and manage their own time.
- Enjoys working within a diverse team in a supportive and helpful manner.
- Pays close attention to detail.
- Is able to work on their feet for 8 hours, in a variety of weather conditions, including heat, rain, and cooler temperatures.
- Is able to lift up to 50 pounds.
- Has a flexible schedule and is available to work evenings, weekends, and holidays.
